Election Day 21 October 2023

Do you want to vote or nominate for the Shire of Koorda Council Elections this year?

If you own, co-own, rent or are the nominee of a body corporate that owns/occupies a property in the Shire of Koorda, you are eligible to vote if you are:

- On the State Electors Register under Koorda, or
- You have submitted an owner/occupier form to the Shire.

Occupier registrations do expire, so please check with the Shire if you are concerned or unsure of your status.

Applications can be submitted at any time up until 4.00pm Friday 25 August 2023.
