With the Harvest Season upon us, we would like to take this opportunity to remind the community about the Harvest Ban and Total Fire Ban announcements.

**SMS Service** - The Shire of Koorda provides a SMS service. If you would like to register for this free service, please contact the office on 96841219 or email shire@koorda.wa.gov.au with your phone number. If you are currently registered for the service but have recently updated your number, please advise the office.

**Radio** - The ABC Radio also announce the bans on air. The designated tune-in time for listeners to hear harvest bans on weekdays and the weekend is 12.35pm.

**Facebook** – All harvest and total fire ban announcements will also be posted on the Shire's Facebook page (Shire of Koorda). DFES will also post total fire ban announcements on their Facebook page (Department of Fire and Emergency Services WA).

The radio will not broadcast the lifting of a harvest ban. The announcement of the lifting will be posted on Facebook and sent out via the SMS service.

Please give staff time to set up the necessary services before seeking further information. Although local authorities are responsible for the placing of harvest bans, due to the vast area of the Shire, farmers must also take responsibility to ensure they carry out their harvesting operations in a safe and timely manner.


