SEROJA LOCAL GOVERNMENT RESILIENCE FUND

The Shire of Koorda wishes to acknowledge the funding contribution of \$500,000 from the State Government for the Seroja Local Government Resilience Fund.

The purpose of the Local Government Resilience Fund will enable the 16 local governments impacted by Cyclone Seroja to undertake works to improve the resilience of evacuation facilities and other community infrastructure, or improve resilience in the community.

Within the 2023/2024 Budget, the Shire nominated seven projects, that worked to improve community resilience, enhance evacuation facilities and increase community infrastructure.

Project 1: Koorda Recreation Centre (Evacuation Centre 1) Ablution Block

Project 2: Koorda Memorial Hall (Evacuation Centre 2) Ablution Upgrade

Project 3: Purchase of new Mollerin Fire Tender

- Project 4: Koorda Recreation Centre (Evacuation Centre 1) Generator
- Project 5: Generators (2 x portable, 1 x fixed to the Koorda Health Centre)
- Project 6: Portable Communications Tower
- Project 7: Water Tanks (5 x 32,000L)

We are pleased to announce we have completed five of the seven projects, with project 1 (Evac Centre 1 Ablution Block) and project 6 (communication tower) still to be completed.



Project 2: Koorda Memorial Hall (Evacuation Centre 2) Ablution Upgrade.

Upgrades were undertaken both internally and externally to ensure the facilities at the hall are adequate to house community members in emergency evacuation situations. The original plumbing at the hall was compromised from tree roots, and all external pipes were replaced to ensure the toilets were functioning at full capacity. Internally, the toilets and basins have been replaced with more modern fittings.

Project 3: Purchase of new Mollerin Fire Tender & Project 7: Water Tanks (5 x 32,000L) The purchase of the new Mollerin Fire Tender and strategic placement of 4 water tanks around the Shire has enabled a more efficient fire emergency response and water network in the more remote parts of our Shire. The water tanks are to compliment areas that are some distance from the scheme pipes and stand pipes to ensure access to water during a fire emergency is achievable. The fifth water tank is reserved for the Recreation Centre.



Project 4: Koorda Recreation Centre (Evacuation Centre 1) Generator & Project 5: Generators (2 x portable, 1 x fixed to the Koorda Health Centre).

The portable generators will serve as versatile and essential assets that can be deployed to various locations within the community during emergencies.

The Shire again wishes to acknowledge the funding contribution of \$500,000 from the State Government for the Seroja Local Government Resilience Fund.


