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# CURRENT EMPLOYMENT VACANCY POOL AND MAINTENANCE OFFICER

We are looking for someone who wants to work half the year managing the town swimming pool and the rest on our gardening team.

A new position of Pool and Maintenance Officer has been created at the Shire of Koorda to manage the free-entry town swimming pool for 24 weeks of the year on a six day 48-hour week and then in the off-season a 24 week 28-hour week with the gardening team.

## Who we are:

The Koorda Shire is in the north-eastern Wheatbelt about 230km from Perth and half an hour drive from nearby towns. The predominate industry is agriculture (wheat and sheep) and the main town includes a primary school, swimming pool, supermarket, community gym and thriving sports community.

## What you get:

The total remuneration package is up to \$76,500.

It comprises a base salary of \$64,831, statutory superannuation (currently 11%) and additional 7% superannuation Shire contribution if matched by employee. Full PPE is provided, including clothing and footwear, and \$50 rent assistance.

The position also has the option of a Shire house with rent currently at \$80 per week.
